Walkway Repairs - CTI has completed the repairs to the walkways, but we continue to have voles pop up the bricks. Please let Mill House know if you are having vole problems with your walkway. Also, we have found several walkways that are flooding during some of the heavy rains we have had lately. One of these was repaired this month. We are making a list of the remaining and will work with the Drainage Committee to develop a solution to the flooding.

Garage Doors – Before calling Mill House if your garage door will not close, please check to see if the electronic sensors at the bottom of the door frame are blocked by trash, leaves, pine straw or spiders. Sometimes the sensors get bumped when putting items in the garage and they get out of line. All of this will cause the door to not close or sometimes not open.

Garage & Porch Lights – Call Mill House if your outside garage light is burned out. To replace your front porch light, you can purchase the Port Oxford, model number 23212 on the Home Depot web site. If you want a smaller one the model number is 23211.

Deck Inspection - The Maintenance Committee has finished inspecting original decks. We have recommended a vendor for these repairs and work should begin soon. Reminder: the HOA will only make repairs to original decks. Maintenance such as power washing, staining, or painting is the homeowner's responsibility.

Garage Window Inspection – Sixteen garage windows were replaced this year. If your garage window does not stay open, please let Mill House know so that it can be placed on the list for future repairs.

When the temperature drops these colors emerge as the green chlorophyll in the leaves disappears, allowing the yellow xanthophylls and the orange carotenoids to shine. The red anthocyanins are created by the conversion of sugars in the cooler weather. The result is a beautiful display of color that never fails to disappoint.
